


Ad Libitum Tempranillo Blanco 2010

Bodegas Juan Carlos Sancha has a monopoly on Tempranillo Blanco. The story is a bit lengthy to go into here but laboratory analysis confirmed its reality. The wine was fermented and raised in stainless steel and bottled without filtration. It offers up a reticent nose while, in the glass it is dry with elevated acidity. There are hints of lemon and citrus but this is a wine that demands food. Whether it is more than of novelty interest, future vintages will tell.
